Other duties will include using evidenced based screening tools to deliver early intervention, treatment and linkage services up to inpatient hospitalization as indicated.

Qualified candidates will possess an LISW or LPCC. Excellent written and verbal communication skills. High level of interpersonal skills to handle confidential and potentially politically sensitive information. Possess proven knowledge and skill relative to mental illness and related dynamics, risk, and diagnostic assessments; therapeutic communication; crisis triage and intervention; de-escalation; treatment modalities; and service delivery systems in behavioral health and related fields. Demonstrate sensitivity, empathy, objectivity, professionalism, effective customer service skills, and sound clinical judgment. Familiar with Microsoft Excel. Able to collaborate effectively with care teams in a variety of medical and healthcare settings, particularly within the Emergency Department. Able to exercise balanced judgement in evaluating situations and making decisions, and to handle difficult and confrontational situations in a calm, consistent, and equitable manner. Must have or be willing to obtain an NPI number, Ohio Medicaid provider number, and CAQH account.
