Background: The Mental Health, Drug & Alcohol Services Board of Logan and Champaign Counties is a public behavioral-health authority established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 340 and created by Amended Substitute House Bill 317. Its statutory mandate is to plan, fund, and evaluate the system of mental health, alcohol, and drug addiction prevention, treatment, education, and consultation services for residents of Logan and Champaign Counties.

As a county behavioral health board, MHDAS does not provide direct clinical services. Instead, it assesses community needs, contracts with certified and accredited provider agencies, and ensures that a full continuum of care is accessible and high-quality. Funding for these services comes from federal and state allocations, as well as local levy support.

Why Services Are Being Procured

MHDAS procures services to ensure the right care for the people of Logan and Champaign Counties, grounded in continuous assessment of local behavioral health needs. The Board regularly gathers feedback through community surveys, client feedback, and collaboration with local leaders and partner organizations. This allows the Board to identify gaps, track emerging trends such as overdose patterns or youth mental health needs, and strategically purchase services that respond to those needs.

The Board seeks contracted providers because this model ensures:

- A broad, specialized network of services
- Capacity to scale or modify programs based on data
- Compliance with state-mandated standards
- Fiscal stewardship through performance-based oversight

- Community-specific flexibility while maintaining statewide best practices.

This RFP includes 4 programs: Prevention Services, Behavioral Health Services, Peer Recovery Support Services, and Property and Housing Management Services. A Provider can choose to submit a proposal for any aspect of this RFP. Providers may apply for an entire program, for just one smaller piece of a program, or for any combination of program pieces that your organization is able to provide. It is not necessary for a Provider to apply for all programs.

This RFP and all resulting contracts are governed by the procurement requirements set forth in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 340, as well as all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. In the event of any conflict between these requirements and other procurement regimes, the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 340 and the Board's procurement policy shall control.

Providers responding to this RFP should be aware that the procurement process is not subject to general county procurement rules, but rather to the specific statutory and regulatory framework applicable to MHDAS Boards under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 340 and related Board policies.

Should the RFP's narrative description conflict with the executed contract's confidentiality/data sharing terms, the executed contract controls.

The Mental Health, Drug & Alcohol Services Board of Logan and Champaign Counties incorporates Procurement Policy 103 by reference, and the Board will follow its adopted rules, operating procedures, standards, and bylaws.

Proposals must identify which needs/priorities in the Board's plan the application addresses and must explain how performance metrics support those priorities.

Board Oversight/Investigation Clause: The RFP and sample contract require timely cooperation, records access (as permitted by confidentiality laws), and incident reporting pathways consistent with the Board's responsibilities as listed in ORC 340.03.

This RFP uses a competitive selection process and will remain publicly posted for no fewer than 10 business days. All communications must follow the instructions in Section 5.
